(Information as of June 2022)

- Take the "Drive-thru Travel/Work Covid test "Rapid 30 min RT-PCR test \$190" course.
- Reservations must be made in advance through the website (as of June 2022, reservations can be made for multiple time slots even the day before).
- Print out the format of the certificate designated by the Japanese government and bring it with you (you can fill in your name and date of birth in advance by yourself)

- On the day of the appointment, park your car at the designated location (parking lot behind the
  hospital), turn on your car lights, and wait for the staff to arrive. \*Although the reservation
  completion e-mail states the above, it is more reliable to call the phone number listed in the
  reservation completion e-mail after you arrive, as the staff may not show up. When I called, I was
  told to go inside the hospital and was examined in what looked like a hospital hallway.
- After the examination, return to your car and wait. 40 minutes or so later, I received my certificate (two types: the Japanese government certificate I brought with me and the hospital's own certificate).
- Please check if there is any mistake on the certificate you received.



- Check to see if the testing method meets the Japanese government's specifications.
- If covered by insurance, the test is free of charge. If there is no insurance coverage, it is possible to take the test at your own expense.

for free, even if you do not have insurance. There are also many sites that will accept you
without an appointment. Before giving up, it would be a good idea to go to a walk-in

- Go to https://curative.com/, click on the "Book Now" link, and make a reservation for the location of your choice.
- Once you make an appointment, you will receive a confirmation email with a barcode.
- On the day of your appointment, the test takes only a few minutes, and you will receive the results within 24 to 48 hours. (In some cases, results were received 18 hours later).
- The PDF report of the results meets the required fields of the test certificate and is uploaded to the MySOS app and certified in a few hours.

• The results were emailed to me within 2 hours. Just to be safe, after I got the results, I went back to Walgreens with the Japan prescribed test form to have it signed.

## (Information on 7/24)

- Easy online reservations available. However, be sure to select NAAT.
- Free of charge for all current residents of the U.S. with an insurance card. Be sure to bring it with you at the time of the examination.
- Those residing outside the U.S. (business travelers, etc.) are basically expected to pay. In some cases, travel insurance may cover the test, so you should inquire with your insurance company.

## (Reviewed by a user returning Japan on 7/5)

- Using Walgreens Rapid test which gives results in 2-3 hours.
- I entered my medical insurance information, but no bill was sent to me personally.
- The Rapid test is also available in Naat, which is on the list of testing methods required for entry into Japan.Walgreens also has PCR, but it takes 1-2 days.
